
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We organise Kedarkantha trek during the Spring/Summer (March to May) and in Winter (December to February). The trip itinerary is from Dehradun to Dehradun (6 days) including 4 days of trekking. For latest Fixed Departure Trek Schedule please check:

*** Trekkers need to reach on their own to Dehradun on Day 1 early morning (by 8 am) or the previous night. Return to Dehradun on Day 6 evening (by 7 pm). Arrange your tickets for inward journey and back to home from Dehradun accordingly ***



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The Trek Highlights:

Length: 6 days from Dehradun to Dehradun; 4 days of trekking. Walking from Sankri and back around 22 Km.

Access: Trains/Flights to New Delhi or directly to Dehradun (Jolly Grant). One can reach Dehradun via overnight trains/buses from New Delhi and can return to New Delhi from Dehradun overnight. Drive to Sankri is around 200 km via Mussorie, Yamuna Bridge, Naogaon, Purola, Mori and Netwar.

Highest Point: Kedarkantha peak ~ 3820m/12,500ft

Grade: Easy, snow in winter/spring

Seasons: March to June and November to February

About Kedarkantha Trek:

Kedarkantha (also referred as Kedarkanta) Peak (3820m) is situated in Govind National Park of Western Garhwal. Surrounding Tons river valley, with remote villages, snow capped mountain ranges in the horizon, and rich flora and fauna of the national park makes the short and easy walk to the Kedarkantha peak a enjoyable hiking experience. In clear weather, the renowned peaks like, Swargarohini, Bandarpoonch, Black Peak can be seen from the summit. The panorama or far stretched ridgelines are a delight to watch. In winter or spring, the trail remains covered with fresh snow. Snow patches amidst giant pine forest and snow covered meadows, in altitude as low as 10,000ft, even in late April, makes this trek a unique one.

<u>Access to Sankri (The trek base):</u>

Depending upon the trek members we can arrange a pickup and drop from Dehradun to Sankri and back. This will be shared equally by the team members and is approximately 6000 Rs one way. One such Jeep can accommodate 6 to 8 people.

Dehradun is well connected by train with New Delhi/ Kolkata. Overnight buses are also available from New Delhi Kashmiri Gate ISBT and takes 6 to 7 hours. The nearest airport is Jolly Grant, about 20km away from the city.

If any trekker wants to reach Sankri by public transport,

1) There are 2/3 privately operated bus services from Dehradun (near DDN railway station on Gandhi road) to Sankri. The 200 Km journey will take around 10/12 hours. The buses start at 5:30/6/7 am.

2) While returning from Sankri take the morning bus to Dehradun/Vikasnagar and reach by 7 pm to DDN.



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Day 1: Dehradun to Sankri drive - 200Km - 9/10 hrs

Day 2: Trek to Juda Tal - 5Km - 4/5 hours

Day 3: Trek to Kedarkantha base - 5 Km - 3 hours





Day 4: Trek to Kedarkantha peak and back to Kedarkantha base - 7 Km - 6/7 hours

Day 5: Trek to Sankri -- 8 Km - 4/5 hours

Day 6: Drive from Sankri to Dehradun - 200 Km - 8/9 hours

Arrange your return journey from Dehradun NOT before 8 pm on Day 6

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<u>Cost & Services for Fixed Departure Treks:</u>

TREK FEE: ₹ 7800 per person (Sankri to Sankri) + 5% GST

The above cost essentially includes everything a trekker may need during the trek and during the stay at Sankri. Details are mentioned below:

Inclusions:

- Two night's accommodation at Sankri (Day 1 & Day 5) in home stay/lodge on sharing basis and dinner.
- All meals during the trek. Regular Indian style nutritious vegetarian food during the trek (including occasional eggs), breakfast packed/hot lunch (depending upon the time you reach a campsite), snacks, dinner along with coffee/tea/soup.
- Experienced and professional Trekking Guide(s). He will be a local to this particular area having sound knowledge of the trekking trail.
- Specialised Cook, Support staff, Porters/Packed Animals for carrying the central logistics of the trek.
- *Permit fee, camping charges, forest levy inside Govind National Park as required for the trek.*
- *Camping in tents (3 persons dome or ridge shaped tents) during the trek.*
- Sleeping Mattress and Sleeping Bag (If you have your personal sleeping bag for high altitude trek, we advise to bring the same for hygienic reason).
- Micro Spikes/Crampons and Gaiters if needed.
- *Basic First Aid and Medical kit.*
- Accidental Insurance Policy covering high altitude trekking tours (For Indian nationals it is included in the TREK FEE, up to 60 years of age). It covers your entire trek as well as your return trip to Dehradun.

Exclusions:

- Transportation cost from Dehradun to Sankri and back.
- → We assume that you will carry your personal Rucksack/Backpack with all your personal belongings. If you want to offload your Rucksack and carried by our Pack Animal/Porter then you need to pay additional ₹ 1000 for the entire duration of the trek. The Rucksack should not weigh more than 10 Kg.
- Any tip/gratuity to the HT supports staff. If you are happy with the service, please tip them generously.
- *Any cost which is not mentioned in the "Inclusions" or personal in nature.*
