Sir/Madam,

The proposal to open more mountain peaks for Mountaineering & Trekking in all the Himalayan States was under consideration of the Government. Now, it has been decided to open 137 mountain peaks, located in Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Sikkim to foreigners desirous of obtaining Mountaineering Visa ('MX') for climbing/trekking on these 137 mountain peaks as specified below:



2. Subject to necessary clearances by appropriate authorities for issue of Inner Line Permits/PAP/RAP, as the case may be and clearance by security agencies, the following guideline may be adhered to:

- (a) The expedition team will not carry a satellite phone and thuraya unless prior permission taken from Department of Telecommunications (DoT), Ministry of Communication.
 - (b) All information gathered including photos will be shared with local formation.
 - (c) Members will not enter/film or take photographs of any installation without consent from local formations.
 - (d) Expedition will strictly follow the approved routes for induction and de-induction.
 - (e) Members will not cross over to the areas where prior explicit security clearance is required.
2. These instructions shall come into force with immediate effect.




